# The Silence of a Falling Tree

### **COMPOUND (Singapore)**

*"When in isolation, I notice that my anxieties and insecurities are amplified. I feel like I am falling into an echo chamber. My thoughts keep ringing over and over again. Over and over again. Until the inevitable decay.* 

\*Sigh\* The silence that follows is just as unbearable. So resonant. So fleeting. I am forced to recall the vastness of my existence. Here I stand listening to quiet trees. Wondering when they would fall."

*The Silence of a Falling Tree* is an immersive sonic journey that draws inspiration from the existentialist notion of essentiality. Tracks are arranged like a guided meditation; woven with original compositions, instructions, dialogue, Foley, and field recordings.

Participants are to encounter the work at recommended locations, while observing social distancing measures.

Synopsis: "I am the tree. Concerned with my breath. I feel energy coursing through my veins. I am rooted to this body. I can ground myself. My awareness blooms like petals after the rain."

Location: Park

Synopsis:

Instructions:

1. Find time to be in a park you have not been to in a while.

2. Ensure you observe safety regulations.

3. Play the track on your earphones. \*4. Enjoy contemplating your voice in the universe.

They play an epic beyond your wildest imagination; in an attempt to calm the anxieties of the isolated space; in hopes to appease their yearning for an old friend.
